

Guidelines for the AddRan Paper Contest

Each spring, TCU's AddRan College of Liberal Arts sponsors its Festival of Undergraduate Scholarship and Creativity. Undergraduate students with majors or minors in AddRan are invited to submit original work—research, prose narrative, or poetry—for presentation at the spring event. An important aspect of this festival is the Paper Contest. Research and creative projects accepted by the AddRan Festival may also be submitted to the Paper Contest. Each entry must be submitted electronically by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, **April 4th, 2012**, as an e-mail attachment to Jan Quesada (j.quesada@tcu.edu). Submissions must also conform to the following guidelines:

Length: no more than 20 pages of text (approximately 7500 words)

Formatting: 12 point font, double spaced, one inch margins on 8.5 x 11 inch paper

Number of entries per student: one

Authorship: single or multiple

Audience: The paper will be evaluated by professors volunteering from various departments in the AddRan College. As we cannot guarantee that they will be able to read highly technical papers or those written in foreign languages, it is recommended that you write for a general audience. Please check with us if you have any questions.

Important note: *Papers submitted to the Paper Contest must also be presented at the Festival in order to be considered for publication.*
